NOTICE OF VACANCIES FOR PARISH COUNCILLORS

Section 87(2) of the Local Government Act 1972

Two vacancies exist for Parish Councillors for Claygate Parish Council. The Parish Council will fill the vacancies by co-option at the next Council meeting on **Thursday 24th September 2026**

To be eligible a candidate must be at least 18 years of age, and must meet at least one of the following statutory qualifications:

- be included on the electoral register for the parish;
- have lived in the parish or within 3 miles of its boundary for the previous 12 months;
- have occupied land or premises in the parish for the previous 12 months;
- have had their principal place of work in the parish for the previous 12 months.

Prospective candidates should familiarise themselves with the disqualification restrictions under sections 80 and 81A of the Local Government Act 1972.
